RABBITS & RODENTS POST OPERATIVE CARE

Animal Details

WHEN YOU GET HOME

Give hay and bedding as usual and place your pet in a warm, draught free, quiet environment. Ensure they are passing faeces and are alert. Rabbits are very sensitive to the effects of anaesthetics and should be closely monitored.

FEEDING

Food and water should be offered as normal. Try and encourage them to eat, it is very important for rabbits to eat after an anaesthetic. A liquid recovery food is available to buy from the surgery if required. If your rabbit is not eating please contact the surgery.

STITCHES

If your rabbit has stitches, please check them daily for signs of swelling and damage. If your rabbit is likely to chew them a collar can be provided.

FOLLOW-UP

Please give any drugs as directed on the label and make any appointments as advised. This is normally 48 hours post operation. If you have any questions or worries before the arranged check up, please contact the surgery.
